The Member Representative is:

- an excellent communicator
- a person who can develop good relationships internally and externally
- competent in his/her knowledge of the Constitution, rules and duties of office bearers
- able to work collaboratively with Area Representatives
- a good listener and attuned to the interests of Area Representatives and members
- a good role model and a positive image for the Club in representing the Board

Specific duties include but are not limited to:

- act as a conduit between the Board and Club members, for example, serving as liaison in bringing any issues/suggestions/feedback to the Board
- suggest, develop and implement solutions to problems
- collaborate with Area Representatives to coordinate events to enhance members' communication opportunities
- represent their fellow members at Board meetings
- play a part in relaying key messages from the Board to the membership
